Radiographs of the thoracic spine in two imaging planes are provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The osseous and surrounding soft tissue structures of the thoracic and cranial lumbar spine present without abnormalities. The narrowing of multiple intervertebral disc spaces level with the thoracolumbar junction is not appreciated in the VD projection.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Normal thoracic spine

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study of the thoracic spine presents without abnormalities. The narrowing of multiple intervertebral disc spaces level with the thoracolumbar junction is considered due to lateral sacking of the spine. If neurological clinical signs develop, consider cross-sectional imaging to check for underlying compressive myelopathy.
