PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Felt off the bed , limping on the LFL
 Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: mild stumbling , ataxic , clicking sound during checking the range of motion of the neck , sever periodontal disease , BW indicated elevated BUN , T. Protein , Album , Glucose , Chole , ALT, ALP, GGT, low Cl, Monocytopenia , lymphopenia .

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE NECK

An overview including the neck, thorax & abdomen in three imaging planes is provided for review.

BREED

Brussels Griffon

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The vertebral endplates of C2/C3 and C3/C4 present moderate spondylosis formation. Potential v-shaped narrowing of the intervertebral disc space C2/C3 is noted.

SEX

Female Spayed

No abnormalities of the soft tissues of the neck are appreciated.

AGE

15 Years

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Possible discopathy C2/C3
- Spondylosis deformans C2/C3 & C3/C4

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

There is evidence of discopathy level C2/C3 ± compressive myelopathy and mild degenerative changes along the cranial cervical spine. No additional abnormalities of the osseous structures are appreciated, however evaluation of the cervical spine is limited in an overview study, due to rotation and oblique projection. If there is strong clinical suspicion for compressive myelopathy along the neck, complementing workup by cross-sectional imaging might be considered.
