PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Wednesday morning Gus started to limp on his RF. Lesa looked at his paw to see if he had a sticker and Gus yelped. Later when Julian got home in the evening he helped look at Gus's paws and they did not see anything in the paw but he did yelp again.

Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: SWLLING AND PAIN SECOND DIGIT RIGHT FRONT.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE FRONT PAWS

A complete set of radiographs of the front paws is provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The growth plates are age related open.

The second digit of the right front paw presents a mild to moderate circumferential homogeneous soft tissue swelling; the osseous structures of the respective digit present without abnormalities.

The remainder of the osseous and soft tissue structures of both front limbs present no abnormalities.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Soft tissue swelling second phalanx right front limb

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

An underlying cause for the swelling of the second digit of the right front paw is not appreciated and the swelling is most likely traumatic or infectious in origin. Check if the nail is intact or if there is laceration triggering onychitis.

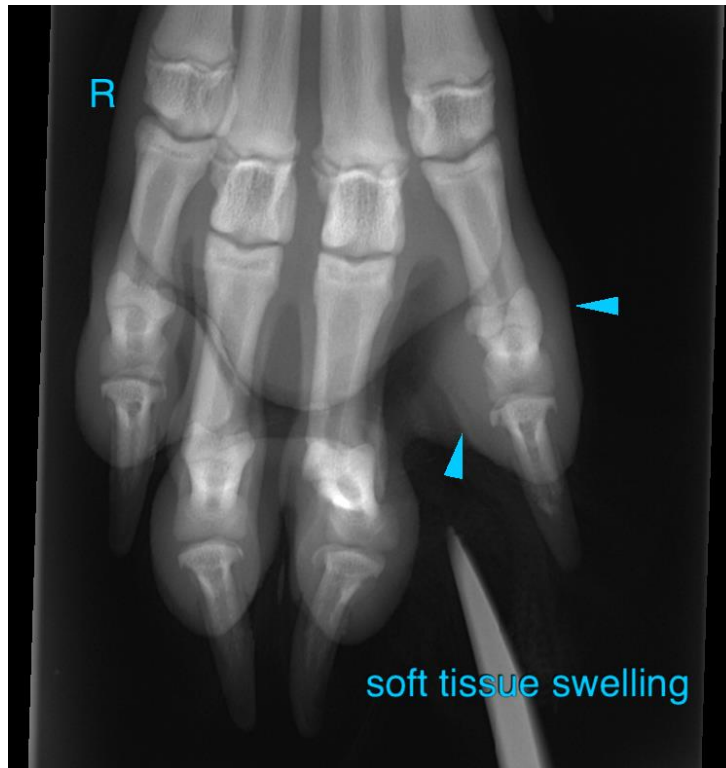
