RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE PELVIS AND RIGHT STIFLE JOINT

A ventrodorsal view of the pelvis and a mediolateral and craniocaudal projection of the right stifle joint are provided for review.

BREED

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The osseous and surrounding soft tissue structures of the pelvis are within normal limits. The coxofemoral joints present smooth osseous margins and a congruent joint space.

The right stifle joint presents smooth margins and without evidence of intracapsular soft tissue swelling.

- Normal pelvis/coxofemoral joints
- Normal right stifle joint

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study of the pelvis and right stifle joint is negative for pathology, no underlying cause for the acute onset of lameness is appreciated. Rule out distortion/contusion and instability of the stifle joint.
