**RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE STIFLE JOINTS**

A complete set of radiographs of the stifle joints is provided for review.

**BREED**

Golden Retriever

**RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

Both stifle joints present a mild prominent intracapsular soft tissue shadow. The osseous margins of the stifle joint are smooth. The patella bilaterally is in situ.

**SEX**

Male

- Equivocal articular swelling stifle joints bilaterally

**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

The radiographic study of the stifle joints are negative for disease. The mild prominent intracapsular soft tissue shadow is likely a normal variant of the physiological amount of synovial fluid. Rule out patellar luxation and instability of the stifle joints. In case of strong suspicion for arthritis, workup can be complemented by a synovial tap.
