**RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN**

Radiographs of the abdomen in three orthogonal imaging planes are provided for review.

**BREED**

Mixed

**RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**The 13<sup>th</sup> right rib is fused to the vertebral body of T13. The vertebral endplates T12/T13 present mild spondylosis formation.

No abnormalities of the extraabdominal soft tissues are noted. The abdominal wall is smooth and thin.

**SEX**

Spayed Female

The serosal detail is maintained throughout the peritoneal and retroperitoneal space.

The liver is appropriate in position, size and presents uniform opacity.

**AGE**

9 Years

The splenic head is in the anticipated position and within normal limits for size and opacity. The splenic body and tail are considered normal for position, size, shape and opacity.

Both kidneys are seen and present with normal size, shape, delineation and opacity. The urinary bladder is in its anticipated position. No radiopaque calculi are noted throughout the upper and lower urinary tract.

The stomach is in its anticipated position and presents normal content.

The small intestinal loops are of even diameter and non-dilated, a small amount of gas is seen within the small intestinal loops and considered within normal limits.
