RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE RIGHT HIND PAW

A dorsoplantar projection of the right hind paw is provided for review.

BREED

Labradoodle

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

There is a generalized moderate circumferential soft tissue swelling of the right hind paw, extending proximally up to the level of the tarsometatarsal joint. Two granular mineralizations are seen superimposed on the soft tissues of the 3rd&4th digit, level with the proximal interphalangeal joint. The osseous structures of the right hind paw are within normal limits.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Generalized soft tissue swelling right hind paw
- Mineralized material superimposed on the soft tissues of the 3rd & 4th digit right hind limb

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The generalized soft tissue swelling of the right hind paw is not specific and potentials include inflammatory, traumatic, neoplastic, lymphedema. No abnormalities of the osseous structures of the right hind paw are appreciated.

The mineralized structures level with the 3rd&4th digit can represent dirt attached to the pads of the respective digits – dystrophic mineralization of the soft tissues are potential as well but considered as an incidental finding.
