PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

History: Chronic vomiting, hx of licking abdomen (pica)
Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Malabsorption panel and T4 pending

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN

A lateral projection of the abdomen is provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

BREED

DSH

Moderate spondylosis formation is seen along the vertebral endplates of the thoracolumbar junction. The lumbosacral intervertebral disc space is moderately narrowed and presents mild spondylosis formation.

SEX

Neutered Male

No abnormalities of the extraabdominal soft tissues are noted. The abdominal wall is smooth and thin.

The serosal detail is maintained throughout the peritoneal and retroperitoneal space.

The liver is appropriate in position, size and presents uniform opacity.

AGE

6 Years

Both kidneys are seen and present with normal size, shape, delineation and opacity. The urinary bladder is in its anticipated position. No radiopaque calculi are noted throughout the upper and lower urinary tract.

The stomach is in its anticipated position and contains a mild amount of gas and fluid.

The small intestinal loops are of even diameter and non-dilated, a small amount of gas is seen within the small intestinal loops and considered within normal limits.

The colon is seen in the expected position and presents with appropriate content.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study presents without clinically relevant abnormalities. There is no evidence of radiopaque foreign material or signs for gastrointestinal mechanical obstruction. No abdominal mass is appreciated. Complementing workup by an abdominal ultrasound examination can be used to screen for mural changes or altered architecture of the parenchymal abdominal organs.
