**PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS**

Splay legged in rear end when jumped off the couch. LH NWB since.  
Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: 4/5 lame left hind, greater trochanter of the femur not palpable cranial to the t. ischii. Crepitus on manipulation of the hip. Remainder of exam typical for age. Re-examination after x-rays shows nearly normal gait and greater trochanter palpable where it should be.

**RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE PELVIS**

Radiographs of the pelvis in two orthogonal imaging planes are provided for review.

**RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

The osseous and surrounding soft tissue structures of the pelvis are within normal limits. Both coxofemoral joints present smooth osseous margins and congruent joint spaces.

**RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS**

- Normal pelvis and coxofemoral joints
