PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Intermittent reported ataxia. On repeat PE, very painful and reactive on abdominal palpation. No GI signs at home.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN

Radiographs of the thorax in three imaging planes are provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The surrounding bony structures are within normal limits.

No abnormalities of the extraabdominal soft tissues are noted. The abdominal wall is smooth and thin.

The serosal detail is maintained throughout the peritoneal and retroperitoneal space.

The liver is appropriate in position, size and presents uniform opacity.

The splenic head is in the anticipated position and within normal limits for size and opacity. The splenic body and tail are considered normal for position, size, shape and opacity.

AGE

15 Months

Both kidneys are seen and present with normal size, shape, delineation and opacity. The urinary bladder is in its anticipated position. No radiopaque calculi are noted throughout the upper and lower urinary tract.

The stomach is in its anticipated position and presents normal content.

The small intestinal loops are of even diameter and non-dilated, a small amount of gas and chymus is seen within the small intestinal loops and considered within normal limits.

The colon is seen in the expected position and presents with appropriate content.
