RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE FRONT LIMBS

A mediolateral view of the shoulder joints is provided for review.

BREED

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The osseous and surrounding soft tissue structures of the shoulder joints are within normal limits.

SEX

MN

Both elbow joints present smooth osseous margins and the surrounding soft tissue structures are within normal limits. A sesamoid bone of the supinator muscle bilaterally is seen.

The osseous and surrounding soft tissue structures of both front paws are within normal limits.

- Normal elbow joints bilaterally

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

Unfortunately, the radiographic study of the front limbs is negative for pathological findings, explaining the front limb lameness. Rule out soft tissue injury as source for the pain as well.
