SPECIES Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Hydration: Appropriately hydrated Mentation: BAR EENT: No nasal discharge; clear no discharge OU; pinnae clean, bilateral TECA; No cough on tracheal palpation. Oral Cavity: mod dental tartar present Lymph Nodes: Symmetrical, no changes in size, shape, consistency Skin: Good hair coat, no signs of ectoparasites. ~8 cm soft freely movable SQ mass ventral thorax (lipoma) CV/Respiratory: No murmur or crackles/wheezing auscultated. Synchronous pulses, normal rate. Normal bronchovesicular sounds. Abd/GI: Soft non painful abdomen, no organomegaly, no abnormalities on abdominal palpation Uro/Perineum: N Musculoskeletal: Ambulatory x3, NWB lame RH. Painful on palpation of 3rd digit RH, 1.5x times larger than opposite toe - no evidence of infection. No joint laxity in R stifle or joint pain in R hip. BCS 7/9 Neurological: Appropriate

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE RIGHT HIND PAW

Radiographs of the right hind paw in two orthogonal imaging planes.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The fourth digit of the right hind paw presents a circumferential moderate soft tissue swelling. The osseous structures of the right hind paw are within normal limits.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

An underlying cause for the swelling of the fourth digit of the right hind paw is not appreciated, there is no sign for accompanying osseous pathology. Differentials include inflammation (e.g. onychitis), trauma or due to the acute onset of clinical signs less likely neoplasia.
