SPECIES

Canine

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ELBOW JOINTS, PELVIS AND STIFLE JOINTS

A complete set of radiographs of the elbow joints, pelvis and stifle joints is provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

BREED

Both elbow joints present mild osteophyte formation at the cranial aspect of the radial head.

Breed

The osseous and soft tissue structures of the pelvis are within normal limits. Both coxofemoral joints present smooth osseous margins and congruent joint space.

SEX

Spayed Female

The patella of the right stifle joint is seen medial to the medial femoral condyle. The osseous structures of both stifle joints are smooth. There are no signs for intracapsular swelling of the stifle joints.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

AGE

9.8 Lbs.

- Very mild degenerative osteoarthritis elbow joints bilaterally
- Right sided medial patellar luxation, considered as an incidental finding

The mild degenerative joint disease of the elbow joints is a possible source for lameness, check if clinically pain can be elicited by manipulation of the elbow joints.

Due to the age of the patient, the clinical relevance of the medial patellar luxation is questionable.
