PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

O hears a click sound when the cat walks, has a hx of arthritis
Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: BW not done, PE- cat stiff & painful when both hind limbs are manipulated, Under sedation- LHL- +ve cranial drawer sign

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE STIFLE JOINTS

Radiographs of the stifle joints in two orthogonal imaging planes are provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Both stifle joints present smooth osseous margins of the periarticular bones and there is no evidence of intracapsular swelling of the stifle joints.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Normal stifle joints

The radiographic study of the stifle joints reveals no abnormalities.
