



PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Teddy Joblon Presents for severe weight loss past few months. Pt has been eating with normal appetite but continues to lose weight. More lethargic than usual. Occasional soft stool. As of today, rDVM reports pet has gained a few pounds.

SPECIES Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Mild muscular atrophy, Cataracts OU, Chronic otitis AU

Canine **COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHY OF THE ABDOMEN**

A high resolution pre- and post-contrast CT study of the abdomen is provided for review.

BREED COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Retriever Mix The serosal fat presents normal attenuation behavior. There is no evidence of peritoneal effusion or peritonitis.

SEX Both kidneys present within normal limits for size, shape and organ architecture. After contrast administration a bilaterally symmetric and uniform nephro- and pyelogram is noted.

Neutered Male The adrenal glands are within normal limits for size, shape and organ architecture.

AGE Both liver and spleen present with normal shape, even surface, uniformly attenuating parenchyma and homogeneous contrast enhancement, unremarkable.

5 Years The portal vein presents a normal order of its tributary veins and intrahepatic branching. No abnormal vessel is noted inside and outside of the liver parenchyma.

INTERPRETED BY The pancreas is evenly contoured, the pancreatic parenchyma is homogeneous and presents uniform contrast enhancement.

HOSPITAL NAME The bony and surrounding soft tissue structures reveal no abnormalities.
