RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE LUMBAR SPINE AND STIFLE JOINTS

Radiographs of the lumbar spine in two imaging planes are provided for review.

BREED

Mixed

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The lumbar spine presents with moderate image noise. The osseous and surrounding soft tissue structures of the lumbar spine are within normal limits.

SEX

The patella of the right stifle joint is superimposed on the medial femoral condyle in the craniocaudal projection. The right stifle joint presents a mild intracapsular soft tissue swelling.

The periarticular bones of the left stifle joint present mild to moderate osteophyte new bone formation.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Degenerative osteoarthritis left stifle joint
- Suspect right sided medial patellar luxation and mild articular swelling of the right stifle joint

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The most common cause for the degenerative osteoarthritis of the left stifle joint is pathology of the cranial cruciate ligament ± meniscal pathology.

The clinical relevance of the medial patellar luxation in this older patient is unclear and if there is evidence of lameness other causes, such as pathology of the cranial cruciate ligament need to be ruled out.
