**PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS**

Presented to RDVM March 2021 for excessive licking of lips and air. Extraction of 210, 301, 302, 401, 402. Left tonsil appeared enlarged and was biopsied. P recovered well but then began licking excessively on left side of mouth again.

**SPECIES**

Canine

Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Histopath (left tonsil): generalized nonspecific reactive lymphoid hyperplasia with mild plasmacytic transformation, random foci mild tonsillar hemorrhage; tonsillectomy appears narrowly complete.

**COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHY OF THE SKULL**

A high resolution pre- and post-contrast CT study of the skull is provided for review.

**COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

**SEX**

Triadan 210, 301, 302, 306, 401 and 402 are absent.

The nasal cavity presents the expected aerated spaces between thin & even conchae and turbinates with smooth mucosal lining.

**AGE**

6 Years

Both temporomandibular joints present congruent joint spaces with even subchondral bone surfaces and are considered within normal limits.

Both tympanic bullae are aerated, the mucosal lining is not seen, the bony wall is smooth and thin. The external ear canals are within normal limits.

The brain presents no deviation from normal anatomy and symmetry. The brain parenchyma is homogeneous and within normal limits for attenuation and distribution of contrast enhancement. The ventricular system is non-dilated and symmetric.

The submandibular and medial retropharyngeal lymph nodes are small and elongated with a normal short-to-long-axis-ratio is < 0.5, the attenuation and contrast enhancement pattern is uniform.
