PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Three and a half month history of coughing in patient. Cough has been unresponsive in treatments with antibiotics, antihistamines, and steroids. Chest x-rays are unremarkable.

SPECIES

Canine

COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHY OF THE SKULL

A high resolution pre- and post-contrast CT study of the skull including the neck is provided for review.

BREED

Beagle

COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The tooth element 208 is absent.

SEX

Male Neutered

The nasal cavity presents the expected aerated spaces between thin & even conchae and turbinates with smooth mucosal lining.

The lens of the left eye presents a significant decreased diameter and is displaced ventrally but still in the plane normal imaging plane.

AGE

14 Years

The left condylar process of the left mandible presents a small crescent shaped defect.

Both tympanic bullae are aerated, the mucosal lining is not seen, the bony wall is smooth and thin. The left external ear canal presents a mild irregular thickened epithelial lining of the horizontal segment.

The brain presents no deviation from normal anatomy and symmetry. The brain parenchyma is homogeneous and within normal limits for attenuation and distribution of contrast enhancement. The ventricular system is non-dilated and symmetric.

HOSPITAL NAME

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Clinic

The submandibular and medial retropharyngeal lymph nodes are small and elongated with a normal short-to-long-axis-ratio is < 0.5, the attenuation and contrast enhancement pattern is uniform.

The anatomical structures of the neck present no abnormalities.

COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Absent triadan 208
- Left sided mild otitis externa
- Suspect posterior subluxation left eye
- Normal upper airways

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INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The CT study presents no abnormality, explaining the cough. Bronchoscopy including BAL can be used as advanced diagnostic test and screen for inflammatory lower airway disease.
