Blossom Law Not eating, vomiting twice since yesterday, history of diarrhea for 2 days. Need to rule out hairball vs obstruction vs others

SPECIES RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN

Feline Radiographs of the abdomen in three imaging planes are provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

BREED The surrounding bony structures are within normal limits.

Domestic Longhair No abnormalities of the extraabdominal soft tissues are noted. The abdominal wall is smooth and thin. The serosal detail is maintained throughout the peritoneal and retroperitoneal space.

SEX The liver is appropriate in position, size and presents uniform opacity.

Female The splenic head is in the anticipated position and within normal limits for size and opacity.

AGE Both kidneys are seen and present with normal size, shape, delineation and opacity. The urinary bladder is in its anticipated position. No radiopaque calculi are noted throughout the upper and lower urinary tract.

7 Years The stomach is in its anticipated position and is empty.

INTERPRETED BY The small intestinal loops are of even diameter and non-dilated, a small amount of gas is seen within the small intestinal loops and considered within normal limits.
