PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Have history of not eating. Vomiting ten times, has blood vomit and blood diarrhea. abdominal tense.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN

Radiographs of the abdomen in three imaging planes are provided for review.

BREED

Chihuahua Mix

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The surrounding bony structures are within normal limits.

SEX

Male Neutered

No abnormalities of the extraabdominal soft tissues are noted. The abdominal wall is smooth and thin.

The serosal detail is maintained throughout the peritoneal and retroperitoneal space.

AGE

4 Years

The liver is appropriate in position, size and presents uniform opacity.

The splenic head is in the anticipated position and within normal limits for size and opacity. The splenic body and tail are considered normal for position, size, shape and opacity.

Both kidneys are seen and present with normal size, shape, delineation and opacity. The urinary bladder is in its anticipated position. No radiopaque calculi are noted throughout the upper and lower urinary tract.

The stomach is in its anticipated position and is empty.

The small intestinal loops are of even diameter and non-dilated, a small amount of gas is seen within the small intestinal loops and considered within normal limits.

The colon is seen in the expected position and is empty.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The empty gastrointestinal tract in combination with the current clinical signs are compatible with (hemorrhagic) gastroenteritis. There is no evidence of radiopaque foreign material or signs for gastrointestinal mechanical obstruction. Recommend empirical management.
