PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

- hind legs tend to shake on and off
- slower up and down the stairs
- was limping on left hind a few months ago but has since resolved

Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: crepitus left hock, pain on extension of right hip, and resistant to extension of left

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE PELVIS AND STIFLE JOINTS

Radiographs of the pelvis in a VD view and the stifle joints in two orthogonal image planes are provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The osseous and surrounding soft tissue structures of the pelvis are within normal limits. Both coxofemoral joints present smooth osseous margins and congruent joint spaces.

Both stifle joints present smooth margins of the periarticular bones and no sign of a pathological intracapsular soft tissue swelling.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Normal pelvis and coxofemoral joints
- Normal stifle joints

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study reveals no abnormalities and an underlying cause for the presenting clinical signs cannot be specified. There is no evidence of hip dysplasia nor signs of degenerative joint disease/effusion of the stifle joints.

The information and recommendations provided are based on the images presented by the referring veterinarian/sonographer. No evaluation can be communicated regarding pathology that was not visible in the image/video clips provided.
