



**PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS**

Luna Bombace vomiting ~ 1 week, still eating. No diarrhea. Per o does not get into anything.  
Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Bw attached - P defecated during pe and noted a piece of tape in stool.

**SPECIES RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN**

Canine Radiographs of the abdomen in three imaging planes are provided for review.

**RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

**BREED** The surrounding bony structures are within normal limits.

**DSH** No abnormalities of the extraabdominal soft tissues are noted. The abdominal wall is smooth and thin.  
The serosal detail is maintained throughout the peritoneal and retroperitoneal space.

**SEX** The liver is appropriate in position, size and presents uniform opacity.

**SF** The splenic head is in the anticipated position and within normal limits for size and opacity.

**AGE** Both kidneys are seen and present with normal size, shape, delineation and opacity. The urinary bladder is in its anticipated position. No radiopaque calculi are noted throughout the upper and lower urinary tract.

6 Years The stomach is in its anticipated position and presents normal content.

**INTERPRETED BY**

The small intestinal loops are of even diameter and non-dilated, a small amount of gas is seen within the small intestinal loops and considered within normal limits.

**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

**REFERRING VET**

The radiographic study presents without abnormalities. There is no evidence of radiopaque foreign material, abnormal gas pattern or signs for gastrointestinal mechanical obstruction. Regarding the history, a piece of tape was appreciated in the stool – might have been a source for the vomiting when passing the intestinal tract. If clinical signs are refractory to therapy, recommend follow up radiographs or a complete abdominal ultrasound examination.
