

**PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS**

Coco Drake Patient has a 4 month history of intermittent retching/coughing. Previous x-rays submitted to sonopath from 7/6/2020 for vomiting issues that may be able to be used for comparison. History of metastatic carcinoma left axillary lymph node- had mammary carcinoma removed 2019.

**SPECIES RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORAX**

Canine Radiographs of the thorax in three imaging planes are provided for review.

**RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

**BREED** The vertebral endplates T10/T11 present moderate spondylosis formation.

Pointer Mix The extrathoracic soft tissues present homogeneous without abnormalities.

**SEX** The heart is of normal size and shape, there is no evidence of cardiac chamber or vascular enlargement. The pulmonary vasculature is within normal limits.

FS The cranial mediastinum presents the expected soft tissue opacity. The mediastinal width is less than twice the width of the vertebral column at the same level.

**AGE** The trachea is normal in diameter and presents the anticipated course. The luminal outline of the trachea is smooth.

11 Years, 4 Months The bronchial tree presents with thin walls and tapers uniformly towards the periphery as expected.

**INTERPRETED BY** The lung parenchyma presents the expected architecture and opacity; the intrapulmonary vascular branching is seen up to the third order lung vessels.

The diaphragm is well delineated with even surface and the expected mild cranial bulging of the diaphragmatic cupola.

- No evidence of pulmonary metastatic disease

**REFERRING VET INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

The radiographic study of the thorax presents no abnormalities, explaining the history of coughing/retching. However, a negative radiographic study does not rule out possible underlying tracheitis/bronchitis. Rule out upper airway disease (e.g. infection, laryngeal paralysis) as source for the described clinical signs as well.
