PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

originally saw patient on 2/21; pt was limping LF limb; PE Left front holding up while standing and dorsal cervical flexion slight resistance; patient is still limping; mild improvement with metacam but still limping

A complete set of radiographs of the front limbs including the cervical spine is provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The radiograph of the cervical spine is moderately rotated. No overt abnormalities of the osseous and surrounding soft tissue structures of the cervical spine are appreciated.

SEX

Both shoulder joints present smooth osseous margins, unremarkable.

The elbow joints bilaterally present no abnormalities.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study presents no specific abnormality, explaining the described clinical signs. However, evaluation of the cervical spine is limited by the rotation. If there is suspicion for pain originating from the neck, cross-sectional imaging can be beneficial to check for compressive myelopathy/neuroforaminal stenosis.
