RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE STIFLE JOINTS

Radiographs of the stifle joint in two orthogonal imaging planes are provided for review.

BREED

Border Collie Mix

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Both stifle joints present smooth osseous margins and without signs of intracapsular soft tissue swelling. The patella bilaterally is in situ.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study of the stifle joints presents without abnormalities. Anyway, check if there is evidence of positive draw sign or tibial compression test. If negative, consider a clinical trial with NSAID and rest and reevaluating the patient in approximately 2 weeks.
