

**PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS**

PATIENT Mochi Tablada Reason for Visit: limping back left leg History: 8 m Pomeranian presented for limping on back left leg onset tuesday. O was not home to know what may have happened.

SPECIES Canine Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Hydration: Adequate Mentation: BAR EENT: OU clear. AU clear, no debris. No cough on tracheal palpation. Oral cavity: Retained deciduous canine teeth x 4, mild tartar Lymph Nodes: Submandibular, prescapular and popliteal lymph nodes normal size, shape and consistency Skin: Healthy hair coat. No ectoparasites seen, skin clean dry and intact. CV/Respiratory: Normal heart rate and rhythm, no murmur, pulses strong and synchronous, normal bronchovesicular sounds. Abd/GI: Soft, non-painful, no fluid wave, no palpable masses or organomegaly. Uro/Perineum: No lesions or abnormalities. Musculoskeletal: BCS = 5/9. Ambulatory x 4, mild weightbearing lameness left pelvic limb. Orthopedic exam: crepitus on flexion/extension of both stifles but no cranial drawer elicited. Resents left hip extension but not until approximately 85% fully extended.No discomfort on right hip extension. Neurological: Alert and appropriate. No deficits noted.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE PELVIS

SEX Male Radiographs of the pelvis in two orthogonal imaging planes are provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

AGE 8 Months The osseous and surrounding soft tissue structures of the pelvis are within normal limits; the growth plates are age related visible. Both coxofemoral joints present smooth osseous margins and congruent joint spaces
