PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

History: o/r fell between trusses got stuck yelped now limping LF, edfu normal, friend administered gabapentin last night.

Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: left fore pain isolated to the elbow on flex and internal rotation

COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHY OF THE ELBOW JOINTS

A pre- and post-contrast CT study of the elbow joints in a bone and soft tissue reconstruction is provided for review.

COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Both elbow joints present smooth margins of the periarticular bones. The medial coronoid process of both elbow joints is well-defined and has a homogeneous density. The surrounding soft tissue structures of both elbow joints reveal no abnormalities.

COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Normal elbow joints

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The CT study of the elbow joints reveals no abnormalities and an underlying cause for the left front limb lameness cannot be specified. There is no evidence of elbow dysplasia.

The information and recommendations provided are based on the images presented by the referring veterinarian/sonographer. No evaluation can be communicated regarding pathology that was not visible in the image/video clips provided.
