



**PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS**

**Pheobe Waalkes** History: NWB RF lameness x 1+ day. Mild WB lameness started yesterday after playing with other dogs, got worse after resting in crate. NSF on orthopedic exam of thoracic limbs - no pain on palpation of long bones; no carpal or elbow joint effusion; normal ROM in carpi, elbows, shoulders w/o pain or crepitation on flexion & extension. Afebrile.

**SPECIES**

Canine Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Intermittent non-weight bearing R thoracic limb lameness. Shifts weight off the limb intermittently when stationary.

**BREED RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ELBOW JOINT**

Boston Terrier A craniocaudal view of both elbow joints is provided for review.

**SEX RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

Spayed Female Both elbow joints present smooth osseous margins, no abnormalities of the surrounding soft tissue structures are appreciated.

**AGE RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS**

11 Months

- Normal elbow joints bilaterally

**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

**INTERPRETED BY** The radiographic study of the elbow joints in a craniocaudal view presents without abnormalities. Consider a clinical trial with rest and NSAID and reevaluating the elbow joints if clinical signs are refractory to therapy – follow up radiographs in two orthogonal imaging planes would be ideal.
