**PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS**

History: Vomiting 4-6 months. Started intermittent & is now multiple times daily. Recently reluctant to eat hard food.

Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Weight loss BW: chem, t4, cbc all wnl Started budesonide within the last week, no improvement. Abdominal CT results: mild to moderate diffuse splenomegaly, mild mesenteric lymphadenitis, l7-s1 lumbosacral instability with spondylosis deformans.

**COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE SKULL****BREED**

**COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC FINDINGS****SEX**

Spayed Female

The pictured parts of the dentition are complete and unremarkable in all jaw quadrants.

The nasal cavity presents the expected aerated spaces between thin & even conchae and turbinates with smooth mucosal lining.

**AGE**

5.5 Years

Both temporomandibular joints present congruent joint spaces with even subchondral bone surfaces and are considered within normal limits.

Both tympanic bullae are aerated, the mucosal lining is not seen, the bony wall is smooth and thin. The external ear canals are within normal limits.

The submandibular and medial retropharyngeal lymph nodes are small and elongated with a normal short-to-long-axis-ratio is < 0.5, the attenuation pattern is uniform.
