**RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE TARSAL JOINTS**

Radiographs of both tarsal joints in two orthogonal imaging planes are provided for review.

Both tarsal joints present smooth osseous margins and the surrounding soft tissue structures are within normal limits.
