RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE LUMBAR SPINE AND PELVIS

Radiographs of the lumbar spine in a lateral view and the pelvis in two orthogonal imaging planes are provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The osseous and surrounding soft tissue structures of the lumbar spine are within normal limits.

The osseous and surrounding soft tissue structures of the pelvis present without abnormalities. Both coxofemoral joints present smooth osseous margins and congruent joint spaces.
