



PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Charlie Eaton Acute onset ptialism 24hrs. Normal exam. Appetite and energy level good. Other pets in the household not exhibiting signs. No history of forgein body ingestion.

SPECIES RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORAX

Feline Radiographs of the thorax in three imaging planes are provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

BREED The body condition score is 8/9.

DSH The surrounding bony structures are within normal limits.

The extrathoracic soft tissues present homogeneous without abnormalities.

SEX The heart is of normal size and shape, there is no evidence of cardiac chamber or vascular enlargement. The pulmonary vasculature is within normal limits.

Male The mediastinum is moderately widened by fat.

AGE The trachea is normal in diameter and presents the anticipated course. The luminal outline of the trachea is smooth.

4 Years The bronchial tree presents with thin walls and tapers uniformly towards the periphery as expected.

INTERPRETED BY The lung parenchyma presents the expected architecture and opacity; the intrapulmonary vascular branching is seen up to the third order lung vessels.
