



PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Henry Williams History: Coughing, sneezing, lethargic. Loud breathing sounds. Heart murmur III/IV and fever on exam.

SPECIES RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORAX

Canine Radiographs of the thorax in three imaging planes are provided for review.

BREED RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

DSH The surrounding bony structures are within normal limits.
The extrathoracic soft tissues present homogeneous without abnormalities.

SEX

Neutered Male The heart is of normal size and shape, there is no evidence of cardiac chamber or vascular enlargement. The pulmonary vasculature is within normal limits.

AGE

2 Years 9 Months The trachea is normal in diameter and presents the anticipated course. The luminal outline of the trachea is smooth.
The bronchial tree presents with thin walls and tapers uniformly towards the periphery as expected.
The lung parenchyma presents the expected architecture and opacity; the intrapulmonary vascular branching is seen up to the third order lung vessels.

The diaphragm is well delineated with even surface and the expected mild cranial bulging of the diaphragmatic cupola.

The radiographic study of the thorax presents without abnormalities of the lung parenchyma nor the bronchial tree, but possible equivocal increased visibility of the bronchial walls. Given the presenting clinical signs upper respiratory tract infection is considered as the top differential.

No abnormalities of the cardiovascular structures are appreciated, however for further evaluation of the cardiac murmur a cardiac echo appears beneficial.
