Blue Pecar HX of right hind lameness. P has been on carprofen and showed no improvement. Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Swelling of tarsus, joint is warm. Grade III/IV lameness

SPECIES RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE RIGHT TARSAL JOINT

CA Radiographs of the right tarsal joint in two orthogonal imaging planes are provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

BREED Level with the right tarsal joint an ill-defined, homogeneous, circumferential homogeneous soft tissue swelling is appreciated. The osseous structures of the right tarsal joint present no abnormalities.

Labrador Retriever **RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS**

- Diffuse circumferential soft tissue swelling right tarsal joint

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

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The soft tissue swelling level with the right tarsal joint is not specific and can be traumatic, infectious or neoplastic in origin. The osseous structures of the tarsal joint present without abnormalities.
