

**PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS**

Pingu Darrow History: intermittent lameness since 3/18/2023, PE revealed slight limp noted on the left front limb once the patient settled down enough to be evaluated - no crepitus or swelling noted - no heat today- flexion and extension is normal on both front limb except for the left shoulder which is uncomfortable on extension. no other abnormality noted 3/30/2023 recheck, owner reported no real change, recommend CT +/- rehab

COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE FRONT LIMBS**BREED**

A high resolution pre- and post-contrast CT study of the shoulder joints is provided for review.

Mixed Breed

COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**SEX**

Both shoulder joints present smooth osseous margins and the surrounding soft tissue structures are within normal limits. The region of the brachial plexus bilaterally is unremarkable.

The CT study of the shoulder joints presents without abnormalities. In case of strong clinical suspicion for pathology of the bicipital tendon or rotator cuff injury, workup can be complemented by an ultrasound examination of the shoulder joints.
