



PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Pickles Herrero Limping on one of the front paws for 2 weeks. rdvm thought maybe due to cracked paws and recommended unknown spray.

SPECIES Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Hydration: Appropriately hydrated Mentation: BAR, jumping around EENT: No nasal discharge; clear no discharge OU; did not visualize AU; No cough on tracheal palpation. Oral Cavity: No dental tartar present Lymph Nodes: Symmetrical, no changes in size, shape, consistency Skin: Good hair coat, no signs of ectoparasites. Mild generalized erythema, esp on front paws CV/Respiratory: No murmur or crackles/wheezing auscultated. Synchronous pulses, normal rate. Normal bronchovesicular sounds. Abd/GI: Soft non painful abdomen, no organomegaly, no abnormalities on abdominal palpation Uro/Perineum: N
BREED Musculoskeletal: Ambulatory x4, holding up RF intermittently, limps on it intermittently. No pain on palpation of ALL 4 limbs. BCS 5/9 Neurological: Appropriate

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE FRONT PAWS

SEX Radiographs of the right front paw in two imaging planes are provided for review.

Male **RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

The osseous and surrounding soft tissue structures of the right front paw are within normal limits.

AGE The axial sesamoid bone of the metacarpophalangeal joint of the fifth digit of the left front paw is irregular.
