**RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE PELVIS**

Radiographs of the pelvis in two orthogonal imaging planes are provided for review.

**SPECIES**

Canine

**RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

The VD projection of the pelvis is moderately rotated.

**BREED**

Golden Retriever

The osseous and surrounding soft tissue structures of the pelvis are within normal limits. Both coxofemoral joints present smooth osseous margins and congruent joint spaces.

**RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS**

- Normal pelvis

**SEX**

Male Neutered

**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

The radiographic study of the pelvis presents without signs of hip dysplasia – be aware, that minor dysplastic changes may be missed due to the rotation of the VD projection.
