## PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Presented for occasionally yelping then rolling to the left when placing weight on the left front limb. This is an obese aggressive dog. Pain response with minimal pressure on the left shoulder joint, even with sedation. No cepitus, swelling, or muscle atrophy palpated under anesthesia.

## RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE SHOULDER JOINTS

Radiographs of the shoulder joints in orthogonal image planes.

## RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Both shoulder joints present smooth margins of the periarticular bones and the surrounding soft tissue structures are within normal limits.

## RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Normal shoulder joints

## INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study reveals no abnormalities and an underlying cause for the described clinical signs cannot be specified. If clinical signs are refractory to therapy, workup may be complemented by cross-sectional imaging including the cervical spine.
