SPECIES RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE SKULL & NECK

Canine Radiographs of the skull in a lateral and rostrocaudal projection and the neck in two orthogonal imaging planes are provided for review.

BREED RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Labradoodle **Skull**

The lateral views of the skull are significantly rotated.

SEX Multiple teeth are absent.

Male The external ear canals are aerated.

AGE No abnormalities of the osseous of the osseous and soft tissue structures are appreciated.

12.3 Years **Neck**

The osseous and soft tissue structures of the neck present without abnormalities.
