PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Favoring left front leg for the past 2-3 months. Physical exam normal. Pt did not seem to favor leg while on rimadyl. Started limping again once off.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE CERVICAL SPINE AND LEFT ELBOW JOINT

A lateral projection of the cervical spine and mediolateral & craniocaudal view of the left elbow joint are provided for review.

BREED

Grey Hound

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The osseous and surrounding soft tissue structures of the cervical spine are within normal limits.

The left elbow joint presents smooth osseous margins, and the contour of the medial coronoid process is sharply delineated and presents a homogeneous density. No abnormalities of the surrounding soft tissue structures are noted.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Normal cervical spine
- Normal left elbow joint

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study of the neck and left elbow joint present without abnormalities, no underlying cause for the lameness is appreciated.

If there is suspicion for pathology of the bicipital tendon or rotator cuff injury, an ultrasound examination of the left shoulder joint can be used as advanced diagnostic test. In case of suspicion for pain originating from the cervical spine, cross-sectional imaging can be used for further workup.
