PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Found yesterday.
 Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Hydration: Appropriately hydrated Mentation: BAR EENT: No nasal discharge; clear no discharge OU; clean no exudate AU; No cough on tracheal palpation. Oral Cavity: No dental tartar present Lymph Nodes: Symmetrical, no changes in size, shape, consistency Skin: Good hair coat, no signs of ectoparasites. No lesions noted. CV/Respiratory: No murmur or crackles/wheezing auscultated. Synchronous pulses, normal rate. Normal bronchovesicular sounds. Abd/GI: Soft non painful abdomen, no organomegaly, no abnormalities on abdominal palpation Uro/Perineum: N Musculoskeletal: Ambulatory x4, no lameness noted. No pain on palpation of limbs. BCS 5/9 Neurological: Appropriate

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE LEFT FRONT PAW

Radiographs of the left front paw in orthogonal imaging planes are provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The growth plates are age related open.

At the lateral aspect of the distal ulnar diaphysis/styloid process a moderate to marked soft tissue swelling is seen and with an associated defect of the cutaneous surface. The distal aspect of the styloid process of the left ulna appears mildly pointed in comparison to the contralateral side.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Marked soft tissue swelling lateral aspect left carpal joint/distal ulna with cutaneous defect
- More pointed distal tip of the left styloid process left ulna

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The swelling and defect are consistent with a local wound and accompanying soft tissue inflammation. The pointed distal tip of the styloid process of the left ulna can be caused by different projection due to rotation or is a sequela to avulsion of a small osseous fragment. Follow up radiographs after remission of the local inflammation might be considered.
