PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

cluster seizures that motivated hospitalization Had 1st seizure in April 2022
Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: There is a mild tendency to lean towards the left when walking in straight line Cranial nerves: Mildly decreased response menace OU, questionable worse OS CSF analysis is normal

MAGNETIC RESONANCE IMAGING OF THE BRAIN

T2 weighted, FLAIR, SWI, diffusion weighted, T1 pre- and post-gadolinium sequence in multiple imaging planes are provided for review.

MAGNETIC RESONANCE IMAGING FINDINGS

The brain presents the expected anatomy and bilateral symmetry with normal signal intensity and contrast enhancement. There is no evidence of abnormal meningeal enhancement.

The ventricular system presents the expected dimensions, morphology and the CSF signal is within normal limits in all sequences.

The tympanic bullae are aerated, and the bony lining is thin.

Surrounding soft tissue structures in the head region are within normal limits.

MAGNETIC RESONANCE IMAGING DIAGNOSIS

- Normal brain

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

In the present study of the brain there is no evidence of macromorphological disease, which supports the presumptive diagnosis of idiopathic epilepsy.

If not yet done so, the workup should be complemented by complete bloodwork to screen for brain disease that is not necessarily associated with structural changes of the brain parenchyma and rule out hepatoencephalopathy and other systemic illness.
