**PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS**

Jumped off a chair 2 weeks ago, was limping on right front leg, seemed to get better but started limping again 2 days ago on the right front limb.

Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Uncomfortable on palpation of the radius-ulna region, Bloodwork- WNL except ALP is elevated 993 (normal 0-140)

**RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE RIGHT ELBOW JOINT**

Radiographs of the right elbow joint in two imaging planes are provided for review.

**RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

The craniocaudal and mediolateral view of the right elbow joint are mild to moderately rotated. The periarticular bones of the right elbow joint present mild to moderate osteophyte formation.

The osseous and surrounding soft tissue structures of the right antebrachium are within normal limits.

**RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS**

- Moderate degenerative osteoarthritis right elbow joint

**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

The degenerative joint disease of the elbow joint in combination with the traumatic insult is suggestive for activation of chronic joint disease. There is no evidence of fracture. Consider a clinical trial with rest and NSAID for at least two weeks.
