PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

had surgery for patellar luxation last April 2021 Macy started screaming today (O did not see fall or see anything happen that was unusual) eating, healthy appetite
Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: no pain for flexion/extension of joints within range of motion sore to be touched in back area

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE LUMBAR SPINE

Radiographs of the lumbar spine in three imaging planes are provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The osseous and surrounding soft tissue structures of the lumbar spine are within normal limits.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Normal lumbar spine

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study of the spine presents without abnormalities. However, negative radiographs do not rule out possible underlying discopathy. Consider a clinical trial with rest and pain management. If clinical signs are refractory to therapy or deteriorate, cross-sectional imaging can be used as advanced imaging modality.
