

**PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS**

Penny Smith About 1.5 yrs ago while waking up from anesthesia (was having toes done) the pet woke up and freaked out. Suspect traumatic event. Recently gotten worse, extremely ataxic, can move neck up/down but not side to side, unable to use front limbs.

SPECIES COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHY OF THE CERVICAL, THORACIC AND LUMBAR SPINE

Porcine A high resolution pre- and post-contrast CT study of the entire spine is provided for review.

COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

BREED In the sagittal reformatted images, there is subjective mild dorsal kinking of the odontoid peg. In the transverse oriented images, no pathologic dorsal kinking of the odontoid peg is appreciated.

Potbelly

The remainder of the osseous and soft tissue structures of the cervical spine are within normal limits.

SEX

No abnormalities of the osseous and soft tissue structures of the thoracic and lumbar spine are appreciated.

COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Structural normal cervical, thoracic and lumbar spine

AGE

5 Years

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

No macromorphological abnormalities are appreciated along the entire spine. However, the negative CT study does not rule out potential intervertebral disc extrusion or ischemic myelopathy. Complementing workup by either a myelographic CT study or MRI study can be considered as advanced diagnostic tools.
