PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

P ADR since may - will not eat hard food or chew on dental sticks. DOesnt want to go for walks. O noted bloody saliva.

Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: 3lb weight loss in 3mo. Mild tartar, no oral masses seen, p unable to fully open mouth even after sedation. Jaw seems painful. Eyes appear sunken and clear discharge OU (worse OS) wbc - 30.9 biopsy of tm pending 2m antibody pending

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE SKULL

A dorsoventral view and a right & left oblique projection of the skull are provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The condylar process of the temporomandibular joint bilaterally is in situ. The temporomandibular joints present smooth osseous margins.

Multiple teeth are absent.

The remainder of the osseous and soft tissue structures of the skull reveal no abnormalities.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Multiple absent teeth

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study reveals no abnormalities that do explaining the described clinical signs. Underlying myositis, either infectious versus immune mediated, may be a potential. Workup can be complemented by a CT study of the skull as advanced imaging modality.
