



PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Hugo Pendergrast Lethargy, panting for 3 days
 Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: 1- golf ball sized soft mass on right armpit, 2- grape sized mass freely movable around right umbilicus, 3- lime sized non-freely movable soft lump on left lateral thorax, 4- blueberry sized soft non-freely movable lump on caudal aspect of left fibula, rest PE unremarkable BW- mild hemoconcentration, T4, cPL- WNL

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORAX

Radiographs of the thorax in three imaging planes are provided for review.

BREED

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Saluki

The body condition score is 7/9.

SEX

The DV view of the thorax is rotate to the right, limiting assessment of the left cranial lung lobe in the DV view.

Male Neuter

The surrounding bony structures are within normal limits.

The extrathoracic soft tissues present homogeneous without abnormalities.

AGE

The heart is of normal size and shape, there is no evidence of cardiac chamber or vascular enlargement. The pulmonary vasculature is within normal limits.

7 Years

INTERPRETED BY

The cranial mediastinum presents the expected soft tissue opacity. The mediastinal width is less than twice the width of the vertebral column at the same level.

The trachea is normal in diameter and presents the anticipated course. The luminal outline of the trachea is smooth.

HOSPITAL NAME

The bronchial tree presents with thin walls and tapers uniformly towards the periphery as expected.

The lung parenchyma presents the expected architecture and opacity; the intrapulmonary vascular branching is seen up to the third order lung vessels.

The diaphragm is well delineated with even surface and the expected mild cranial bulging of the diaphragmatic cupola.
