RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE SHOULDER & ELBOW JOINTS

SPECIES A complete set of radiographs of the front limbs is provided for review.

Canine **RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

The growth plates are age related visible.

BREED Both shoulder joints present smooth osseous margins and the surrounding soft tissue structures are within normal limits.

Maltese Cross

The osseous and surrounding soft tissue structures of the elbow joints present no abnormalities.

SEX RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Female
- Normal shoulder joints
 - Normal elbow joints

AGE INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

6 Months The radiographic study of the shoulder and elbow joints presents without abnormalities. In case of strong suspicion for trauma of the physis, follow up radiographs in 1-2 weeks of the antebrachium are recommended.
