PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

R hind limb lameness x 5 d. Getting progressively worse.
Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Sedated radiographs taken. Minimal cranial door RH.
Painful upon palpation of R stifle.

SPECIES

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE STIFLE JOINTS

Radiographs of the stifle joints in two imaging planes are provided for review.

BREED

Border Collie Mix

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Both stifle joints present smooth osseous margins and without signs of intracapsular swelling. No abnormalities of the surrounding soft tissue structures are appreciated.

SEX

- Structural normal stifle joints

3 Years

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study of the stifle joints presents without abnormalities. There is no signs for degenerative joint disease nor intracapsular swelling of the stifle joints. A clinical trial with rest and NSAID with reevaluation of the patient in 2-3 weeks might be considered.
