



PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Roma Tapia Reason for Visit: Limping History: 1 y/o s,f schnauzer presents for limping on the front right paw. O states that P was licking that paw all night and then this morning was limping on it. O has not seen anything stuck on paw or that she hurt herself, but does think that main large paw pad is sensitive.

SPECIES Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Hydration: N Mentation: QAR, EENT: N Oral Cavity: clean permanent dentition and healthy gums Lymph Nodes: N Skin: very tiny <2 mm in diameter, circular "bump" (cyst?) lower lumbar area; all 4 paws are saliva stained CV/Respiratory: N Abd/GI: N Uro/Perineum: N Musculoskeletal: weight bearing lameness on the (R) front limb. Full ROM manipulation and palpation of all bones and joints: did not produce a pain response, so unable to isolate pain to a particular area Neurological: appropriate, no deficits noted
